Based upon review of the data and FDA approval, the panel consensus was to add nivolumab for patients with unresectable hepatocellular carcinoma cancer (HCC) who are not candidates for transplant; patients with disease that is inoperable by performance status or comorbidity, local disease or local disease with minimal extrahepatic disease only; and patients with metastatic disease or extensive liver tumor burden (Child-Pugh Class A or B7 liver function only).
