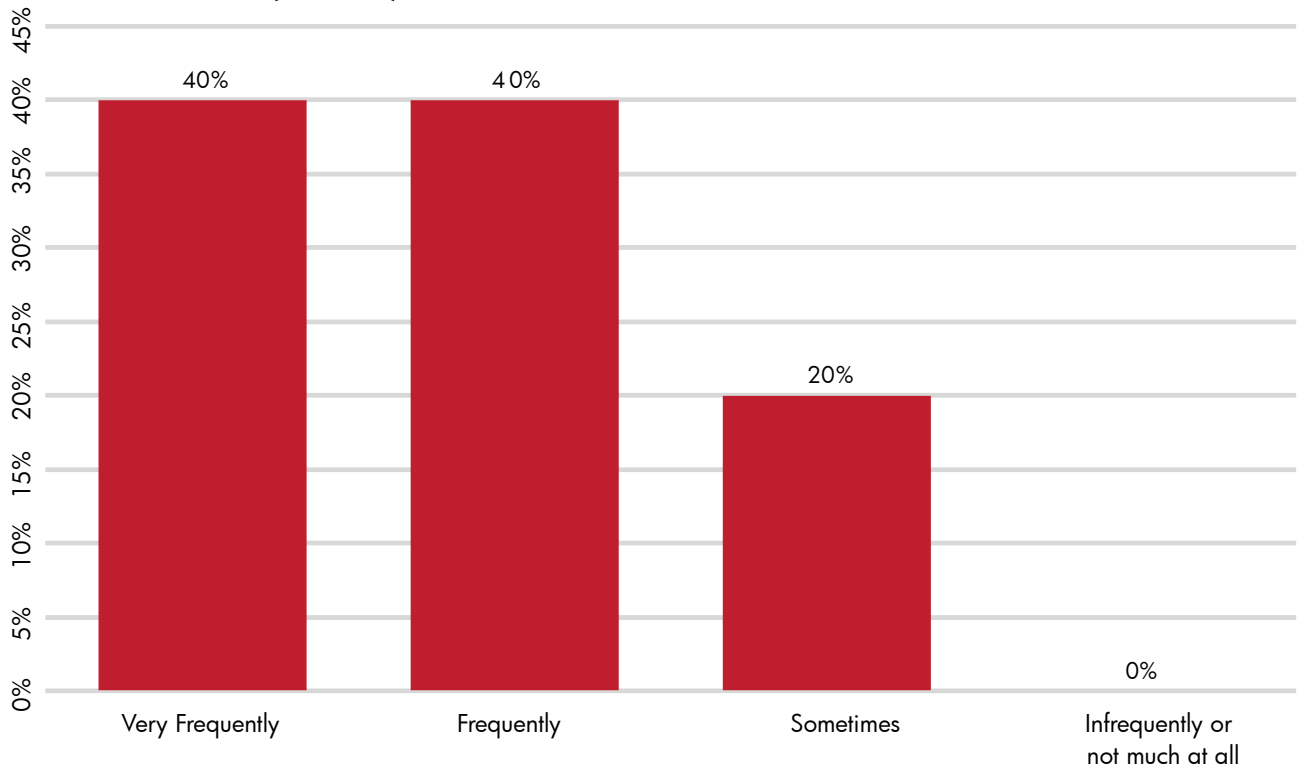

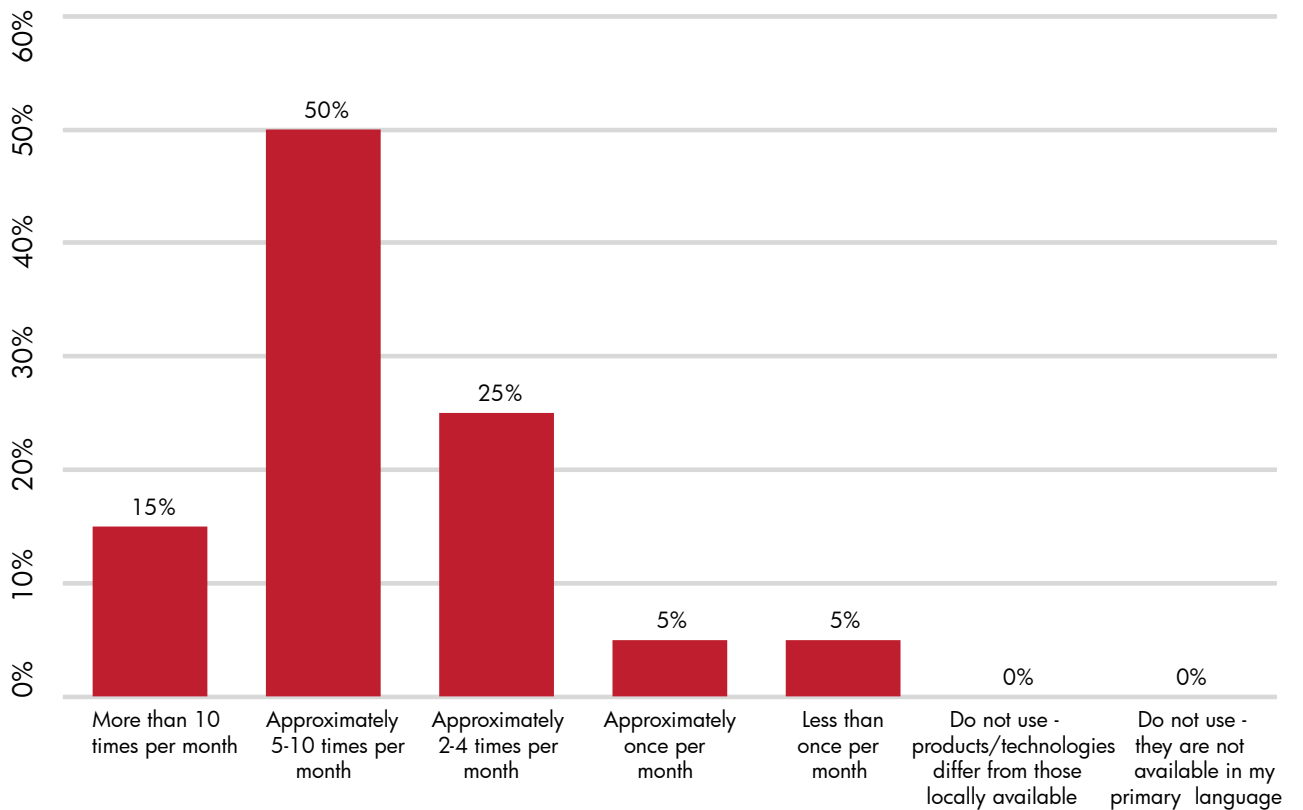

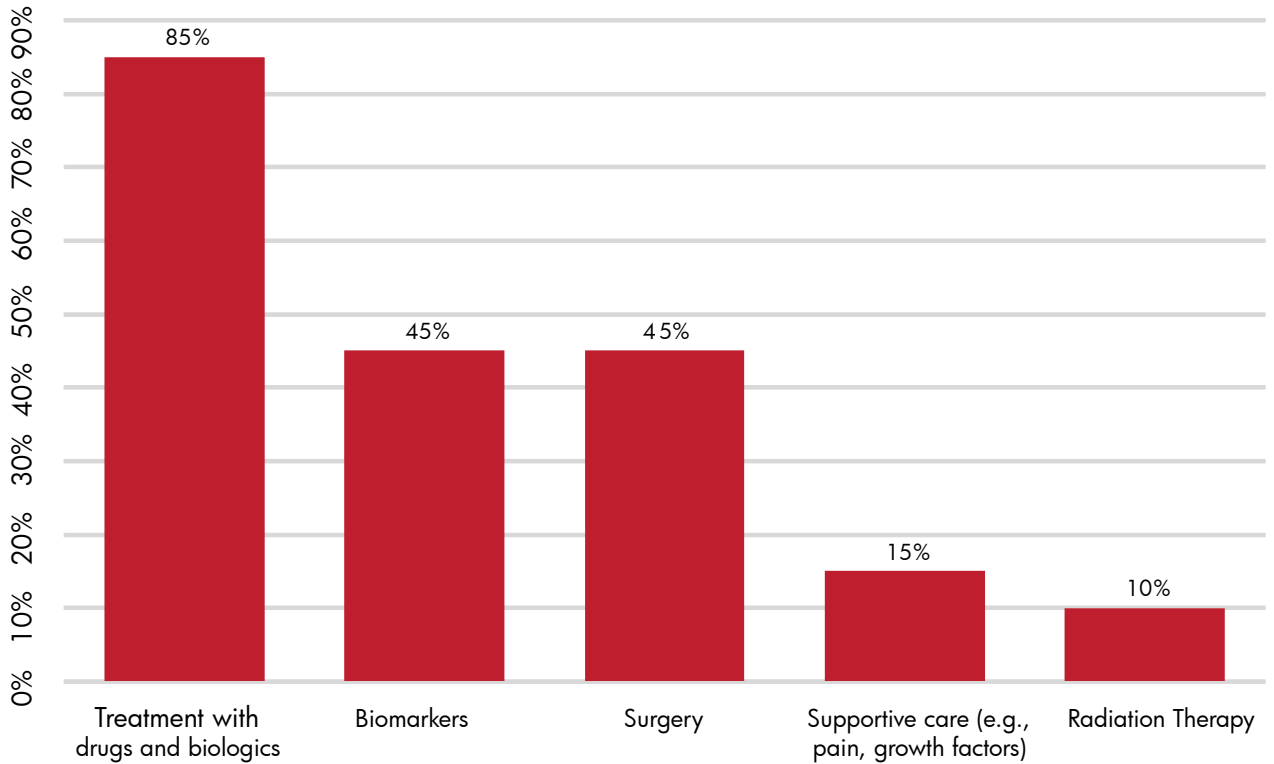
Q2. I use NCCN Guidelines to direct my treatment of patients with cancer: (n = 20)



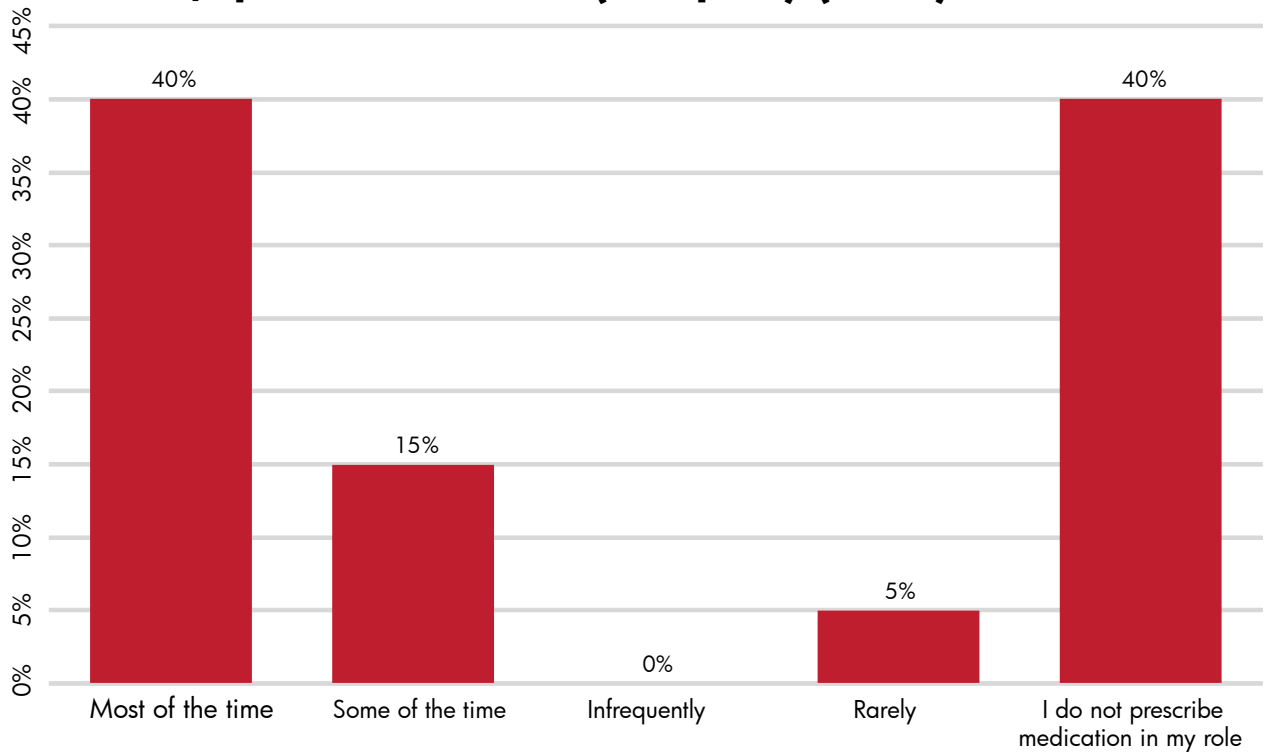
Q3. I use NCCN Guidelines: (n = 20)



Q4. I am most interested in NCCN Guideline recommendations about (please check two): (n = 20)

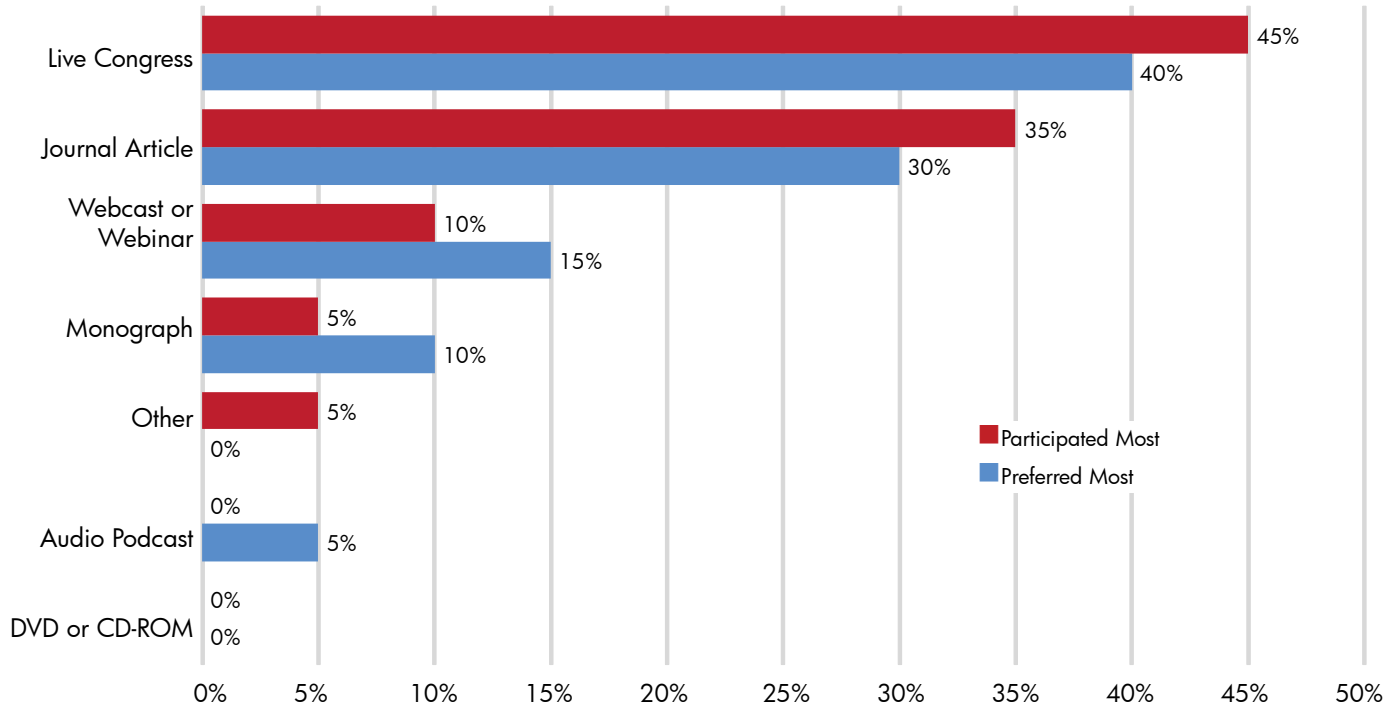


Q5. In the metastatic setting for breast cancer for patients who overexpress HER2, I prescribe trastuzumab (Herceptin®): (n = 20)

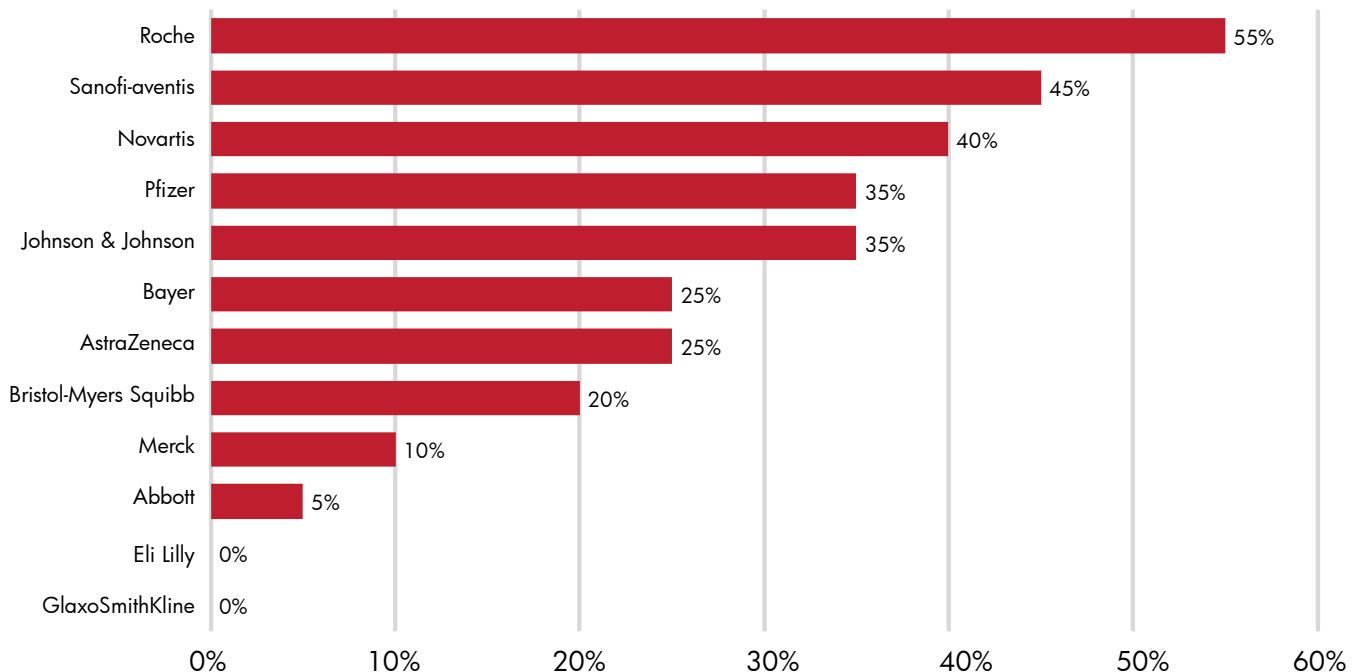
